An example of enacting the Common Good: the Buddy2Buddy School Solar Light Program

At the SCEAA/SEAQ conference last year, one of the most popular presentations was given by Mr Simon Doble, the co-founder and CEO of the program, which is now one of the key suppliers of renewable energy to aid agencies around the world.

The theme of the 2016 conference was *Enacting the Common Good: What does this mean for social and citizenship education?* Simon's program enables children in developed countries to learn how to make a small solar light in their classroom that can then be sent to children in developing countries to enable them to do homework and improve their education - STEM plus a global citizenship perspective leading to the common good of reducing energy poverty in those countries and improving people's lives.
