- Open your video in YouTube and click 'SHARE'
- Copy the video link shown and paste into "Add Video Link" field when registering for this event on the SEAQ site

- SEAQ will open the link to your video and save it to a SEAQ playlist for voting by SEAQ committee by the SEAQ committee after all entries have been submitted.
